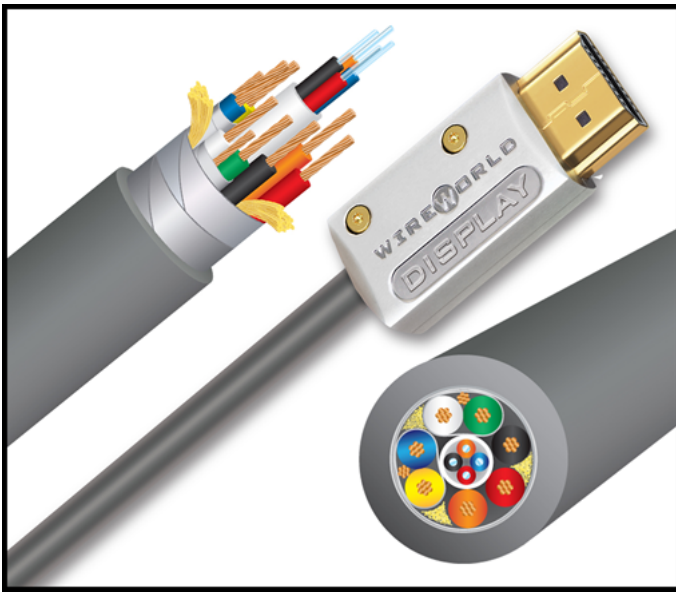


Wireworld Stellar, *The First* Optical HDMI Cable to Receive HDMI® 2.1 Ultra High Speed Certification
